
Event Report: St. Swithin's Bog Twelfth Night




Baronial Twelfth Night... Hear ye's what happened! (Cont.)

Recipes from Xer Ladyskip, Roskeen's Kitcken

THL Rosheen had several requests for recipes after her fabulous 12th Night lunch & feast. Here they are!

12th Night Chicken Recipe:

12th Night Chicken Rivel Soup:

Makes about 10- 1/2 cup servings

Mustard Dipping Sauce- or so I hear it was named "Awesome Sauce"

Makes 8 servings

1/4 c miracle whip (you can use mayo, if you pre-

fer, but I used miracle whip)

2 tbsp fresh dill, chopped

2 tbsp fresh mint, chopped

2 tbsp Dijon mustard2 tbsp white vinegar

2 tbsp sugar

Mix all ingredients until well blended. Chill and

serve.

Rivels

1 c flour

1 egg

1/2 tsp salt

1 tbsp whole milk

Combine all ingredients in a bowl. Mix until dough balls start to form. Pull off small amounts of dough (about the size of your thumb nail) and roll between palms to form small ovals. Set aside.

Chicken

8- 6 oz chicken breasts, flattened

1/4 c sugar

1/4 c fresh dill, chopped

1/4 c fresh mint leaves, chopped

1/4 c white vinegar

1 tbsp salt

1 tbsp olive oil

1 tsp black pepper

Preheat oven to 450 degrees.

Prepare breasts by pounding them to a uniform

1/4 inch thickness.

In bowl, combine sugar, dill, mint, vinegar, salt, oil

and pepper.

Spread mixture over both sides of chicken breast, using a butter brush. Lay chicken on greased bak-

ing tray, not overlapping.

Bake for 10 minutes on each side.

(This recipe is fantastic on the grill, but since I

didn't have a grill, I used the oven.)

Soup

15 oz cream of chicken soup

2 c whole milk

1/2 tsp thyme

2 chicken breasts, diced

1/2 c bacon, crumbled

1/4 c onion, diced

Combine these ingredients in a soup pot. Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally. Lower heat. Add rivels and simmer 15 minutes, or until rivels are cooked.

NOTES ON COMBAT ARCHERY FROM THE GUNTHER GRUNBAUM

On several occasions this past fall the monarchs of our great Kingdom have put out a call for combat archers during their courts. Last year at Pennsic, the Midrealm had a large number of combat archers and used them to great effect. AEthelmearc would like to field as many combat archers as possible at this coming Pennsic War.

Many of you may remember several years ago when this was tried before; a tremendous effort was made to field numerous combat archers only to have a last minute rules change foil the attempt. We are doing a lot of networking and research to avoid having this happen again. There are numerous marshals and combat archery advocates nearby that have been extremely supportive and are will to help out in whatever way they can, including authorizations. I am going to summarize what has been learned so far.

You do not need any other heavy authorization to do combat archery. If it is your only authorization, you will need to take a good shot as part of the authorization. It's not that bad, man up!

Armor requirements are the same as every other heavy weapons participant. Minimum armor requirements aren't bad. Ask for help if you want to armor up.

The Society has just approved 125 psi Siloflex for use as ammunition. We are also allowed to use the old 100 psi Siloflex. Note that the old crossbow bolts were made from 160 psi Siloflex which is why they did not pass inspection.

Parts of the old crossbow bolts are still usable. The rubber stopper, in particular, is easily salvaged and can be reused in new bolts. Bolts are no longer able to have any "fletching" on them and the back end of the bolts must be open. The 150 psi Siloflex can be used to make an APD (Anti-Penetration Device) for fiberglass combat archery ammunition.

The old crossbows that have 3 or 4 fiberglass rods as the prod are legal in AEthelmearc and several other kingdoms. They are also, so far, legal at Pennsic. If you want to make sure your crossbow will pass, you should consider replacing the fiberglass rods with an actual crossbow prod. This part has been a little tricky because we have not been able to find a reliable way to get replacement prods. Also, crossbows are not allowed to exceed 1000 inch/pounds. (Inch/Pounds is the draw weight of the bow multiplied by the distance in inches that it is drawn...Baron Iago has a bow scale for this.)

Some possibilities for replacing the prods are steel prods made by Alchem or Slowbows Crossbows which are running about \$65. These may provide too much draw weight to be legal. Also, replacement fiberglass prods for sport crossbows can be purchased, but the length of the prods may not work with our current crossbow stocks. Any suggestions on how to overcome this problem are welcome.

If you are interested in giving combat archery a try or have any further questions about combat archery, please ask me (garetkane@hotmail.com) or Baron Iago (or come to the business meetings). If you have one of the old combat crossbows lying around and aren't planning on using it, please consider giving it to someone that will.

Combat archery is a great way to support your Barony and Kingdom without putting yourself in the frontlines of the battles.
