We need a pick-up truck to haul stuff. Sherry, when do you want to go shopping at Lowes? The materials needed for the four legged stands are as follows:

3- 8' pressure treated 2x4's, 1-10"carriage bolt with nut and 2 washers, 4-4 1/2" carriage bolts with nut and 2washers. The 2x4's get cut into six pieces and then bolted together. Very simple to make. The 2 tripod stands just need some new 2x4's which I have lying in the garage. I can get the measurements for them if anyone wants to make some of that design.
