DUANE LOHR, "ISTERI"



On December 2, 2022, the Barony of St Swithin's Bog lost a beloved member. Isteri (Duane Lohr) was a fixture at Pennsic with his camper encased in a sheet wall near "piss off point." You could always find him sitting around the fire at night or hanging out at the 'Thirsty Beaver' telling jokes. During the day he could be found in Merchant Alley selling metal and leather goods or on the battle field manning our siege engines. I may not have been around in the SCA very long, but Isteri had made an impression on my heart and he will not soon be forgotten. I got to know he and his wife a little better during the pandemic when they graciously offered up their property for a camping event. They were so kind to all of us during that event and especially made sure that we and our small pup were taken care of.

Having expressed interest in getting authorized to run siege, I spent more time than usual with Isteri at Pennsic 49. We rode with him and the other siege guys to get inspected. And even though he wasn't planning to fight, he wanted to make sure he got his auth sticker so that the collection on his helm would remain complete. We laughed and told stories, all crammed into a little minivan. It was one of my favorite memories of the event. I felt like one of the gang. Isteri's smile and laughter could light up a camp - or in this case a cramped minivan.

Duane was involved in many activities outside of the SCA, but he always made time to haul the siege engines and his camper to Pennsic. In addition to his role in the SCA, he was a retired chiropractor, a member of Lodge 358 F&AM and The Cussewago Rifles, and he loved golfing, boating, fishing, hunting, living history events, and music.

Plans for an informal memorial service at the Bog camp are being planned for Pennsic 50.


