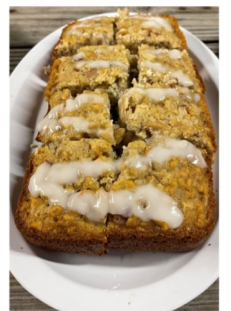
Osa... Thank you for all help in the kitchen and also providing us with beverages and some comic relief as the day went on. You are always a blessing.



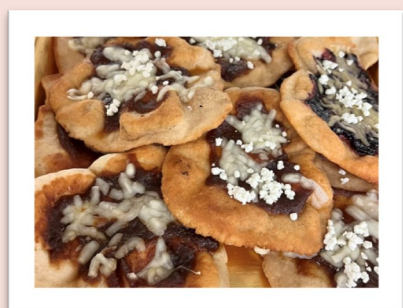
