The Watershed Farm has several acres, including a watershed loop trail and a wetland overlook. The Nimick Family Education Center has one large classroom that has the potential to be split into two as well as an 'unfinished' section that has the potential to serve as a classroom, a dance space, or a fencing area. This section is somewhat open to the elements and could be cold, however, there are two propane powered space heaters that we've been told we're welcome to use, we just need to provide the propane tanks.

There is limited parking directly in front of the education center as well as the adjacent building that serves as the staff's offices that would be set aside for accessible parking and parking for royals. Primary parking is a large field down a slightly sloped hill. The field is a mix of grass and gravel.

The fields adjacent to the parking field are also ideal for archery and thrown weapons classes.

There are paved sections adjacent to the building that can be utilized for tented classrooms and/or heavy weapons fighting.

There is a kitchen on site, however, it is limited to a sink, refrigerator, and counter. The idea that we had for a dayboard was for 'Foraged Foods', i.e. foods that could be foraged such as fruits and nuts, so this space would work for slicing and prepping.

There are two restrooms so the site manager has recommended renting a portajohn. \_\_

No stairs, lower unfinished level accessible from outside door via sloped ground.
